



CLEAN BARN AWARD

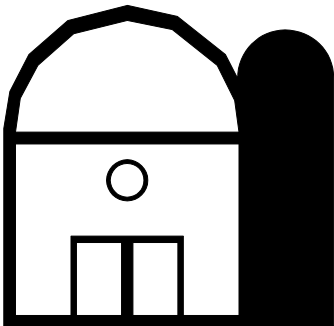
All organizations participating in the 2007 Jefferson County Junior Fair by exhibiting a livestock project are expected to participate in the “Clean Barn” event.

Each of the 7 barns that house Jr. Fair Livestock projects will compete daily, Tuesday–Friday for the Clean Barn Award **Each barn will be judged as a whole. This means that the organizations in each barn must work together in order for their barn to be awarded the “Clean Barn Award”**

***All barns will be eligible for the award every day regardless of the show schedule. This will give everyone added opportunities to exhibit pride in their barn.**

Judging will be done between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. daily. The “Clean Barn” banner will be hung on the award winning barn after each day’s judging is complete. Pizza and soda will be delivered to the winning barn Tuesday thru Friday by 5:00 p.m.

“CLEAN BARN” AWARD CRITERIA



- Walkways clean and neat
- Pens, stalls and tack areas orderly and neat
- Club/Organization’s general area neat and clean
- Behavior and language of Jr. Fair participants respectful
- Practice good sportsmanship towards others while in the barns
- Humane treatment of animals at all times

This award is one of the most publically visible awards given to Jr. Fair Livestock participants. The Jr. Fair Livestock Exhibits provide many general patrons with their most memorable images of the Fair.
